Seymour Shootout Information

- 1. 20 minute running clock halves. Regular rules will apply for the last 2 minutes of each half.
- 2. On a shooting foul, the shooter will be awarded 1 shot. If they make that shot, they will receive 2 points if it was a 2 point attempt or 3 points if it was a 3 point attempt. In the last 2 minutes of each half, the player will shoot the proper amount of FT's. In the last 2:00 of each half, 2 shots will be awarded if there are 7 or more team fouls.
- 3. 2:00 overtime if needed. Regular game clock rules will apply.
- 4. We will keep track of fouls/a player will be eliminated after 6 fouls. We will also keep track of team fouls per half, so that we know when a team is in the bonus for the last 2 minutes. <u>There will not be any bonus free throws until the last 2:00 of the 2nd half.</u>
- 5. Each team will be awarded 3 (:45) timeouts per game.
- 6. Half time will be 3:00.
- 7. Each team will play 3 play games.
- 8. Please make sure that your team is ready to play on time. If there is time for warm-ups, we will allow 3:00. If we are behind, the game will start immediately following the previous game. It is very important that we stay on schedule as much as possible.
- 9. Any intentional flagrant foul will result in an ejection from that game. 2 intentional flagrant fouls during the tournament will result in the player being disqualified for the remainder of the shootout.
- **10.** If a player receives 2 technical fouls during the course of the shootout, she will be disqualified for the remainder of the shootout.
- 11. There will be a \$10.00 admission fee for adults and students/12 years and under will be free. This will cover all sites for the duration of the shootout. Please make sure that your players/parents are made aware of this fee! Players and coaches are free.
- 12. Varsity games will be played at Seymour High School. JV games will be played at Seymour Middle School. We will have people keeping the book and running the clock at both sites!!
- 13. Please make sure that your bench area is clean after every game.
- 14. We will start games at (SHS/SMS @ 11:00)
- 15. AT SHS, PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT ALL TEAMS AND SPECTATORS ENTER DOOR 15.....That will be the entrance unlocked.
- 16. At SMS PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT TEAMS AND SPECTATORS ENTER DOOR 16 (By the Flagpole).

**Note: There is renovation being done to the main gym at SHS. We are hoping for that to be finished by the time we host our shootout. If it is not, the Varsity will play at Seymour Middle School and the JV will play at the 6th grade center (Brand new facility) and Cortland Elementary.
