The following coaches will be our featured speakers:

11:00 - 12:00 Coach Michael Lewis - Head Coach at Ball State University. Coach has spent the last 18 years as a college assistant. His first stop was at Texas Tech with an NCAA Tournament and a 3rd place NIT finish, he went to Stephen F. Austin and Eastern Illinois from 2004-2011. From 2011-2016 he was at Butler, where they went to 3 NCAA Tournaments and to the CBI Sem-Finals. From 2016-2019 he was at Nebraska and earned 2 NIT Tournament bids. His most recent stop was at UCLA from 2019-2022 and he was a part of an NCAA Sweet 16 and Final Four appearance. Coach played for Jasper HS and was a 1996 Indiana All-Star and Gatorade Player of the Year. He played for Coach Bob Knight at Indiana University from 1996-2000.

12:10 - 1:00 pm Coach Marc Urban* - Head Coach at Chesterton HS. Entering his 7th season as the Trojans head coach, they are coming off a 29-1 season and a 4A State Runner-Up. He has an overall record of 124-31. He was the 2022 Times Coach of the Year, District 1 IBCA Coach of the Year and Junior All-Stars Coach. He has won 2 Sectional Championships, 1 Regional Championship and 1 Semi-State Championship. Went 80-17 with Lake Central girls in 4 seasons with 2 Sectional Championships. Player/Student Assistant at Indiana State under Coach Royce Waltman.

1:10 - 2:00 pm Coach Ryan Miller** - Head Coach at Providence HS. Entering his 4th season as the Pioneers head coach, they are coming off a 21-6 season and a 2A State Championship. He has an overall record of 51-22. He was the 2020 Courier Journal Coach of the Year and has won 2 Sectional Championships, 1 Regional Championship and 1 Semi-State Championship.

2:10 - 3:10 pm Coach Scott Davenport - Head Coach at Bellarmine University. In 2005, Scott Davenport became the 11th coach in Bellarmine University men's basketball history, and in six years took Bellarmine all the way to the top by leading the Knights to the 2011 NCAA Division II Tournament national championship. For his efforts, he was named National Coach of the Year by two different organizations: the National Association of Basketball Coaches and the Division II Bulletin. Davenport's career record of 398-130 ranks him as Bellarmine's all-time winningest coach both in terms of total wins and winning percentage (.763). In the 2020-21 season, Davenport guided the Knights to a highly successful transition as an NCAA Division I school. Bellarmine sported a 14-8 record overall and earned an invitation to a national postseason tournament (CBI) after falling just one game shy of capturing the ASUN Conference regular season crown. This past season they were 20-13 and ASUN Tournament Champions. Coach was an assistant for Denny Crum and Rick Pitino at Louisville University. Coach was a 10-year HS coach and a 1988 State Champion with Louisville Ballard HS.
