DATE:

TIMES:

The earliest groups will start play at 9:00 a.m. and be finished around 3:20 p.m. The latest groups will start play at 10:40 a.m. and wrap up around 5:00 p.m. (All times listed are EASTERN Daylight Time.)

COST:

\$200 per team; \$350 for two teams per school

REGISTRATION:

ATTENDANCE/CONCESSIONS:

- Please keep rosters between 8-10 kids and 2-3 coaches max
- Fans are permitted, but there will be a \$5 admission upon initial entry
- No lunches are provided; there are numerous restaurants within 5-10 minutes; there will be concessions at the Auto Park Sports Complex.

FORMAT

GAMES:

- Each registered team will play 3 games
- All games will consist of two 20-minute halves with a running clock
- The clock will stop only for injuries, timeouts, and during the last minute in the second half of a single-digit, competitive game
- Teams will have a minimum 5-minute warm-up and 2-minute halftime
- Free throws will be 1-shot for 2-points; all other rules will follow NFHS
- We will attempt to match teams up against uncommon opponents, keeping in mind competitive level and personnel

SUDDEN DEATH TOURNAMENT:

- All teams will participate in a single Sudden Death Tournament
- This will take place at 2:00 p.m. at the Auto Park Sports Complex
- It is single elimination, untimed, and will move very quickly
- Simply put, the first score wins; ANY foul results in a free throw attempt
