Main Job Tasks and Responsibilities

- Organize, plan, and coach all activities and practices
- Attend all required Athletic Department, DAC, and IHSAA meetings
- Provides documentation in regard to physicals; consent; rosters; awards; eligibility; emergency medical forms; and any other required information in the time frame set forth by the Athletic Department
- Complete the IHSAA/NFHS coach certification program
- Monitor academic performance and assist with college opportunities
- Lead fundraising efforts for the sports program
- Assumes duties which the Athletic Director or Principal deem necessary for the improvement of the program
- Be present at all practices and contests, providing assistance, guidance, and safeguards for each participant. Ensure that athletes are supervised at all times.
- Will be accountable for all equipment and uniforms including the safety, inventory, and storage. Will be required to submit an annual update of inventory to the Athletic Department promptly after the season ends.
- Follow all District, School, and Athletic Department policies and procedures.
